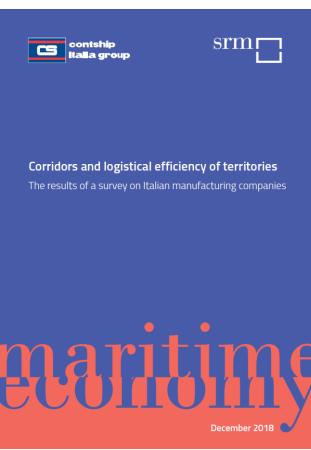

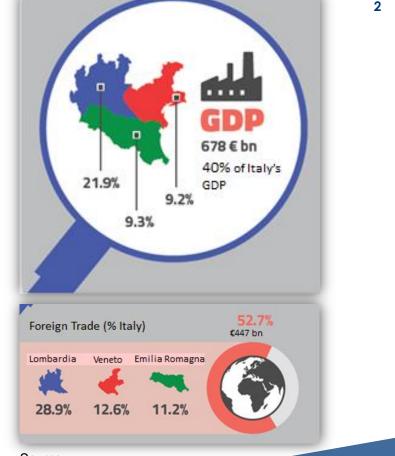

Methodology and objectives

Methodology

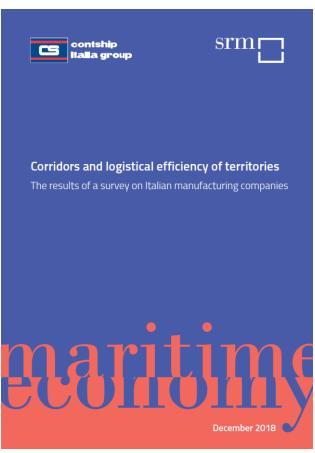
- 400 manufacturing companies surveyed localised in Lombardia (150), Veneto (150) and Emilia Romagna (100). They export/import goods via maritime transport using containers.
- This part of Italy makes up **50%** of Italy's trade. **31%** of their trade uses maritime transport (37% for Italy as a whole).

Objectives

- 1) Understand main **Logistical corridors** for Italy (ports, countries and mode of transports involved in import and export);
- 2) Analyse Management of the **logistical process** (outsourcing; INCOTERMS)
- 3) Monitor efficiency and quality of the Italian Logistcs System through the **Quality Logistics Italian Index** (QLI^2).

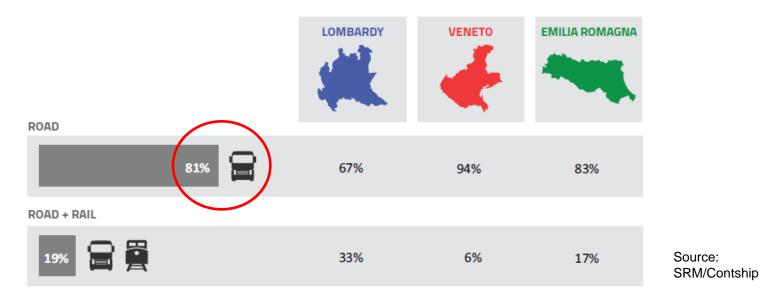




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From companies to ports: Intermodality still low

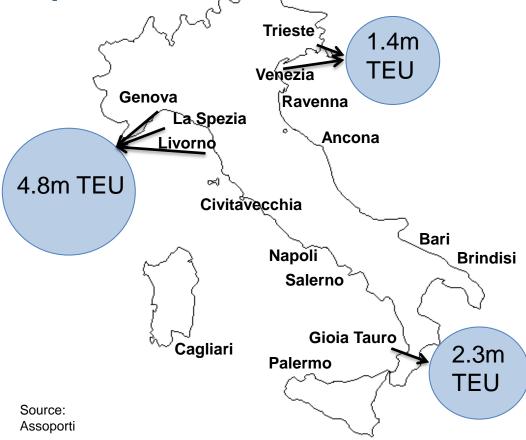


- 81% of companies use only road to transport goods from companies to the port and viceversa. Just 19% use also treins.
- Different data for each region, but everywhere low.



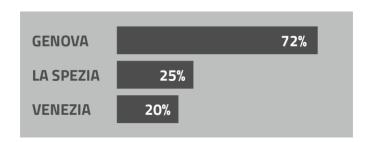
The Italian port system

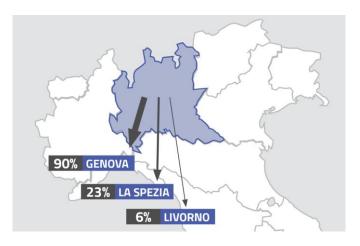
Total 10.6m TEU





North West ports are the main entry to international markets: EXPORT



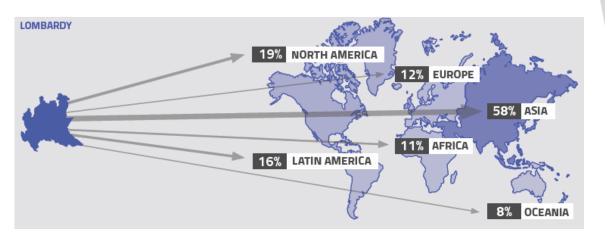


- **72%** of companies say **Genova** is among their 2 top choices when exporting goods. The port of La Spezia and Venezia follow.
- These three port together make up **4.7m TEU** (**44%** of Italy's) and are on the growth (+14%, +16% and +1%)
- Genova is even 90% for companies localised in Lombardia.

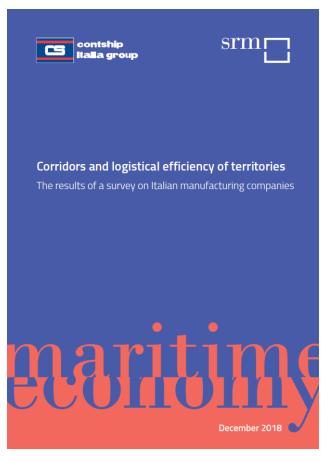
Asia: among the 2 top destination for Lombardia

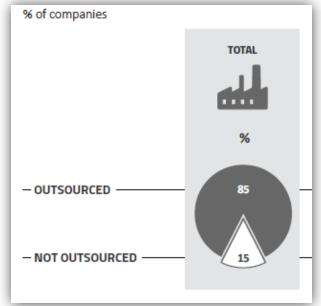


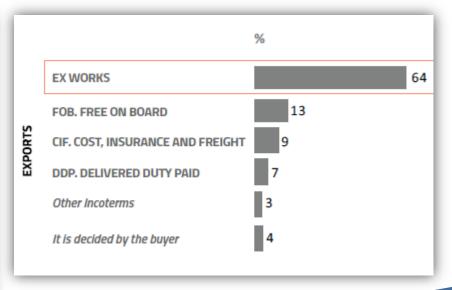
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85% outsource the logistics process. 64% sell by using Ex-work INCOTERM

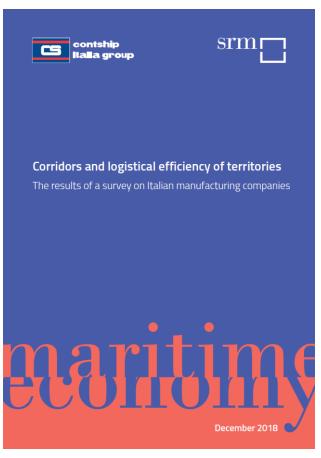

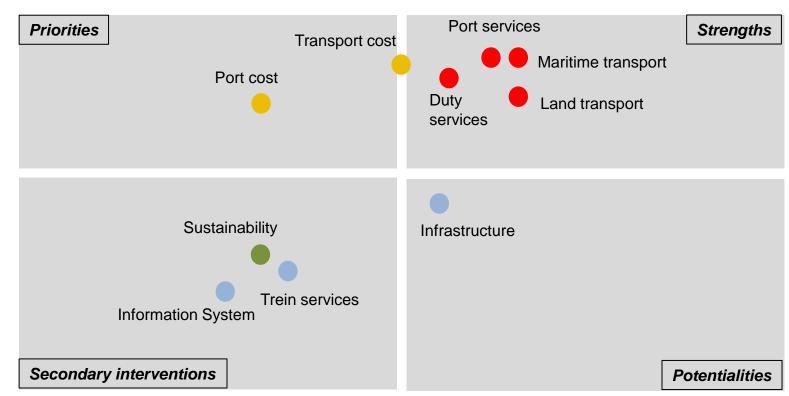

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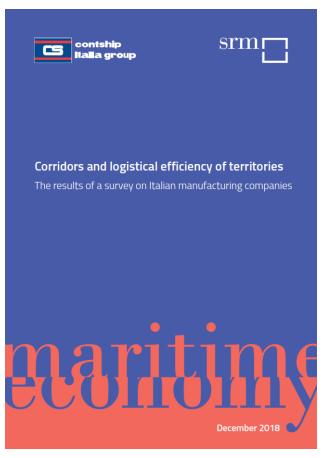
QLI^2: Strenght Priority Analysis
