


#### The MENA Area is increasing its competitiveness


- The gap between the MENA and European has greatly reduced between 2006 and 2019.
- Even the gap with Italy is shrinking.












The analysis of container ports by geographic area: the new role of Med




NORTHERN

- Northern Range market share (39%) is decreased between 2008 and 2018.
- The MED Area can be a great opportunity; between 2008 and 2018 the ports of MED Area increased their market share from 36% to 41%.




#### The Suez Canal: the new records





#### Main oil global chokepoints



- Suez (and the Sumed pipeline) was the 3rd transit route in the world for the transport of crude oil and petroleum products with 5.5 million barrels per day.
- It amounts for 9% of global oil trade and LNG.










## Med is a strategic area for Short Sea Shipping



- Goods transported as part of EU short sea shipping are almost 1.9billion tonnes
- Short sea shipping made up close to 60% of the total sea transport of goods to and from the main EU ports


For SSS, especially in Europe, Rollon Roll-off (RoRo) is almost equally important as container shipping


#### Vehicle exports continue to rise

FORECAST GLOBAL SEABORNE VEHICLE TRADE VOLUMES (MILLION CEU- Car Equivalent Unit). 2017-2022



- Car carrier seaborne volume growth rate is 2.5% a year to 2022.
- Most growth is forecast to continue to come from short-distance Intra-Asian trade(+4,2% annual growth), as well as Asia to Europe (+2,7%)


FORECAST INTRA-MEDITERRANEAN VEHICLE TRADE VOLUMES 2018-2022 (MILLION CEU)







Free Zones employ between 90 and 100 million direct workers




## Free Zones not everywhere are successful: level of utilization


#### How to attract investments in the SEZs
